IS YOUR FACILITY ON THE USEPA RCRA 2008 CORRECTIVE ACTION BASELINE LIST?

If your facility is subject to the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Subtitle C Corrective Action program, check out the 2008 Corrective Action Baseline Lists sorted by state and by facility name on the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) website at <http://www.epa.gov/epaoswer/hazwaste/ca/facility.htm>. Regardless of whether or not USEPA or an authorized state is taking the lead for overseeing corrective action at your facility, if your facility is on the list and your facility has not yet met specific corrective action goals set by the USEPA, expect to see an agency inspector and/or an agency contractor at your facility soon.

The 2008 Corrective Action Baseline list includes almost 2,000 sites targeted for increased agency involvement. In a move to push more facilities toward implementing final remedies, the USEPA has set the following four (4) Government Performance and Results Act (GPRA) goals for the end of its 2008 fiscal year (*i.e.*, by September 30, 2008):

95% Human Exposures under Control

81% Migration of Contaminated Groundwater under Control

36% Final Remedy Decision

27% Final Remedy Construction

The 2008 Corrective Action Baseline Lists, which were current as of May 1, 2007, indicate the status of specific facilities in meeting the above-listed goals.
