Commercial Litigation Experience

- Obtained favorable settlement after a two-week trial defending against a \$54 million destruction of business claim.
- Achieved a \$3.3 million judgment, plus attorneys' fees, on behalf of a corporate officer following an eight day trial against his former employer and a successor company.
- Tried two-week jury trial and obtained favorable verdict involving dispute between shareholders.
- Obtained rare appointment of a corporate custodian after a protracted hearing exposing fraudulent activities.
- Defended against claims of liability asserted against a reinsurance company by the primary insureds and beneficiaries of an employee medical benefits policy.
- Achieved a favorable settlement on behalf of a United Kingdom centrifuge manufacturer in an action brought by a coal processor for damage caused by plant failure.

- Represented several financial institutions in class action securities fraud claims and obtained dismissal of both a complaint and amended complaint, whose dismissal was confirmed by the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Third Circuit.
- Defended a major hospital in bankruptcy court on claims filed against it arising out of the largest municipal bond fraud case in Pennsylvania.
